Dazaifu specialty Umegae-mochi Umegae-mochi is a toasted rice cake with sweet red bean paste inside. It is stamped with the plum blossom pattern that is the symbol of Dazaifu

The origin of Umegae-mochi Sugawara Michizane was exiled from Kyoto and spending a miserable life Out of pity for his circumstance, an old lady who lived nearby gave him a rice cake decorated with a plum tree twig to cheer him up.

Kiuso is a wooden hand-carved craft. It represents that a bullfinch perches on a tree and spread its wings. People believe that bullfinch is a messenger of a god and bring good luck.
