Smoke only in smoking areas.

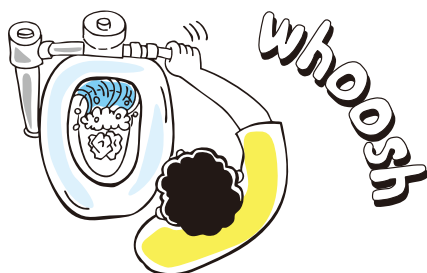


Avoid smoking while walking and use designated smoking areas.

Use public transportation.

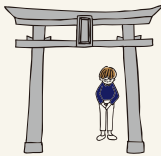
The Beloved Culture of Dazaifu "SAIFUMAIRI"

"SAIFUMAIRI" refers to a pilgrimage to Dazaifu Tenmangu Shrine combined with a sightseeing tour of the surrounding historic sites and landmarks. It became popular among people during the Edo period, and the Umegae Mochi also became a famous souvenir around that time. The bustling scenes of the monzenmachi, filled with many people, continues to breathe life into the culture of Dazaifu in the modern era.

How to Worship at Dazaifu Tenmangu Shrine

01 Bow before passing through the torii gate

Show respect by making a slight bow before walking through the torii gate.



02 Avoid walking in the center of the approach

The center of the approach is considered the route for the gods, so please walk along the edges to the left or right.



03-1 Purify your hands and mouth

Extend your hands and cleanse them.



03-2 Purify your hands and mouth

Pour some water into your hands



03-3 Purify your hands and mouth

Rinse your mouth with the water in your hands.



03-4 Purify your hands and mouth

Finally, cleanse your hands once more.



04-1

Worship at the main sanctuary

【Compose Yourself】
At the shrine, remove your hat and compose yourself.



04-2 Worship at the main sanctuary

【Two Bows】
Stand straight, then bow deeply at a 90-degree angle twice.



04-3 Worship at the main sanctuary

【Two Claps】
Clap your hands twice in front of your chest.



04-4 Worship at the main sanctuary

【Prayer】
Place your hands together and silently convey your gratitude or wishes in your heart.



04-5 Worship at the main sanctuary

【One Bow】
Lower your hands and bow deeply at a 90-degree angle once more.



05 Final bow at the torii gate

On your way back, after exiting the torii gate, turn around and bow once more before leaving the shrine.



By following these practices, you can organize your feelings and reaffirm the gratitude and humility that are often forgotten in everyday life.

Transportation Information

To Nishitetsu Dazaifu Station

From Domestic Terminal of Fukuoka Airport

Take Fukuoka City Subway and Nishitetsu Tenjin Omuta Line.

For about 50 mins

Via International Terminal of Fukuoka Airport
Take the Dazaifu Liner Bus "Tabito."

For about 40 mins

From Nishitetsu Fukuoka (Tenjin) Station

Take Nishitetsu Tenjin Omuta Line and Nishitetsu Dazaifu Line.

For about 30 mins

From JR Hakata Station

Via International Terminal of Fukuoka Airport
Take the Dazaifu Liner Bus "Tabito."

For about 40 mins

From JR Futsukaichi Station

By taxi For about 15 mins

Via Kyushu Expressway

Approx. 6 km from Dazaifu I.C. For about 15 mins

Approx. 8 km from Chikushino I.C. For about 15 mins
